GO Grant funding covers:

Transportation to field trip location:
bus, train, boat or mileage

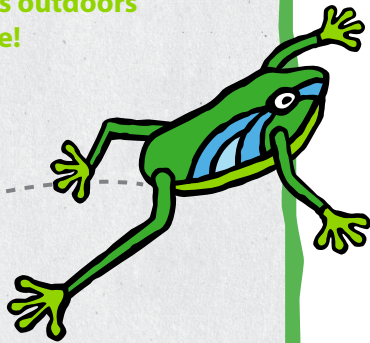
Outdoor field trip equipment
(e.g. dip nets, hand magnifiers, etc.)
or habitat stewardship project
materials (e.g. native plants, student
gloves for planting)

Outdoor field trip leader, secondary
school (grades 9-12) teacher on call
costs and or program fees

Grants for individual class and/or
requests of \$600 or less

Grants for school-wide or
multiple classes greater than
\$600 to a maximum of \$3500

Take your students outdoors and explore nature!



Criteria

The key criteria for GO Grants trips or projects are:

- Conducted **outdoors** in a nature setting
- Focused on learning about **BC's fish, wildlife, habitats or biodiversity**
- Linked to curriculum
- **Hands-on or experiential** for students
- Planned with before and after extensions

maintaining receipts for one full year.
- Submit a final report online.
- Provide photos and/or video.
